CHARACTERISTICS*

CORE

Australian White Wheat (AWW) is a new class introduced in 2021.

It represents value as a dry, clean, hard grained white wheat with competitive milling performance and sound falling number.

AWW has minimum quality guidelines that include wheat and flour specifications (and do not extend to dough testing or to specific end products).

GRAIN ATTRIBUTES

- Hard white wheat
- Sound falling number
- · No specific protein

MILLING PERFORMANCE

- · Competitive extraction rate
- · Good flour colour

QUALITY GUIDELINES

- Minimum classification testing requirements for grain and flour
- No dough or specific end product testing requirements
